## **Mrs. Barbara Pearl Lindstrom**

**M**rs. Barbara Pearl Lindstrom age 83 of Lantana, Florida passed away peacefully on July 6, 2015 with her son and daughter-in-law by her bedside. Barbara was born in Rochester, New Hampshire on January 5, 1932 to her parents, Mr. Eugene Henry Seavey and Mrs. Gladys (nee Groleau) Seavey. Her father passed away when she was only eight years old, and she and her mother moved to Worcester, Massachusetts shortly afterwards where her mother met and married Barbara's beloved stepfather Harry Bullens.
