Committal services will be at Palm Beach Memorial Park Cemetery.

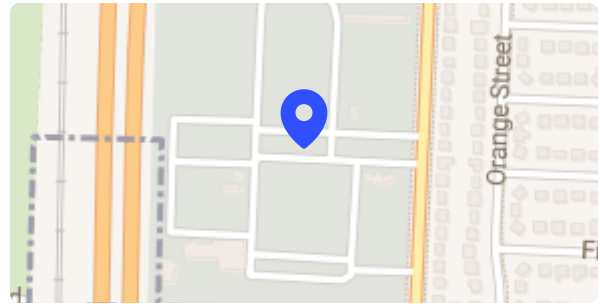

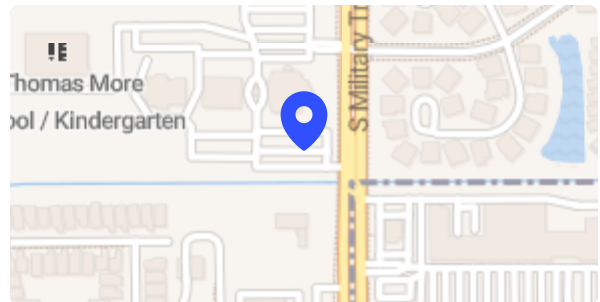

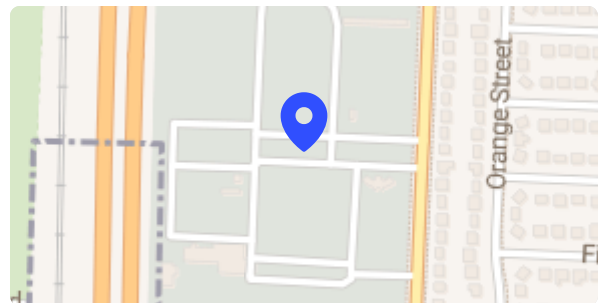
