Rest In Peace Dad.






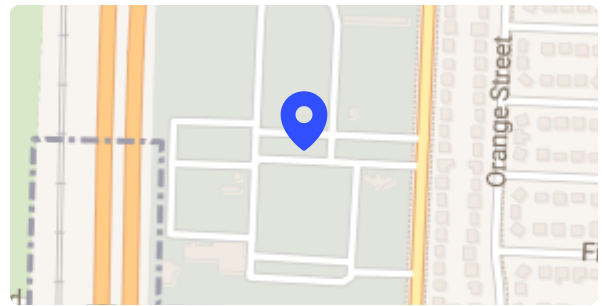

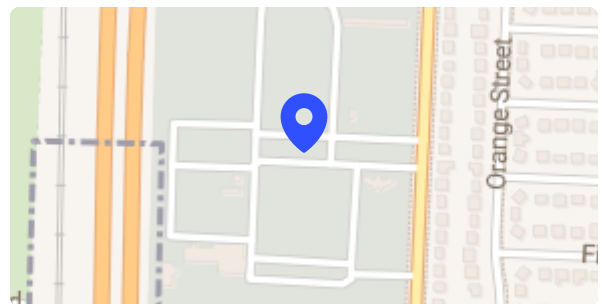

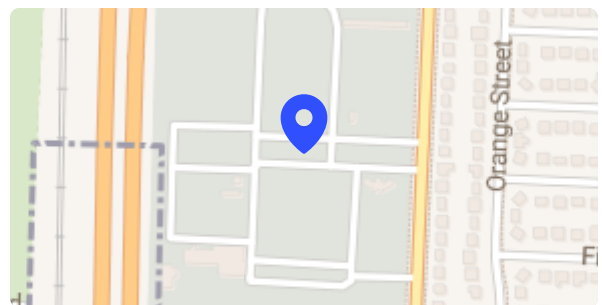
