Mavis Pearl Jones passed away on December 15, 2020, at the age of 90. Mavis was born February 1st, 1930 in Ginger Hill, St. Elizabeth Jamaica, W.I. She was the baby of ten children and the last surviving child of T.C. and Ira Jones. She attended Ginger Hill Primary School before moving on to Windsor High School in Kingston, Jamaica.

In 1958, Mavis moved to London, England taking her two children. There she met her partner Kenneth Bryd, who sadly passed in the early 1970's. She also made two special friends Louisa and Vivia, Louisa also passed away in the early 1990's and Vivia, most recently on December 16, 2020. 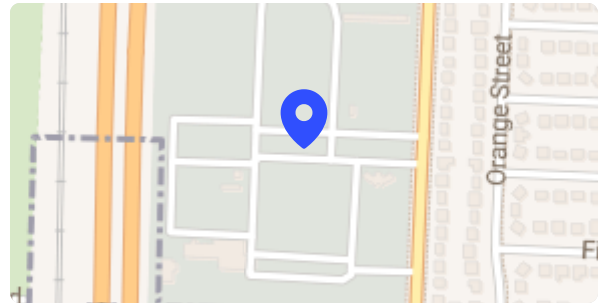

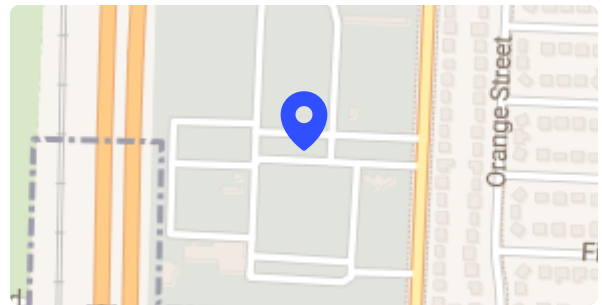

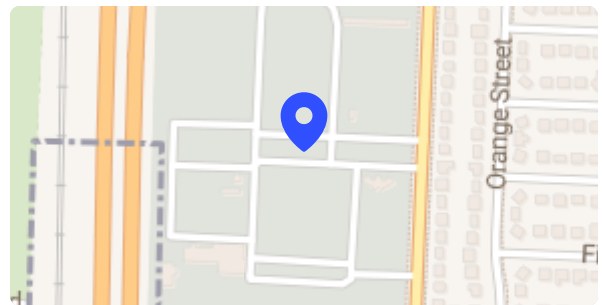
