Ivy, thank you for all the love and affection you gave us, we will always remember your humility and sincerity. You were our sister, friend and counselor and you will always be our role model.

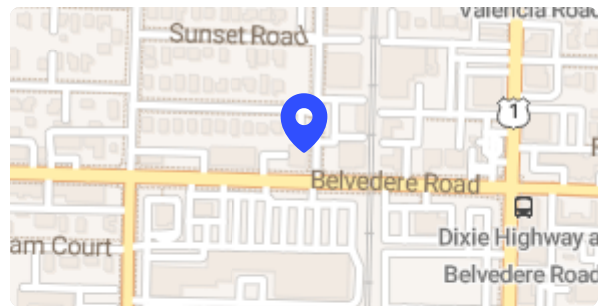

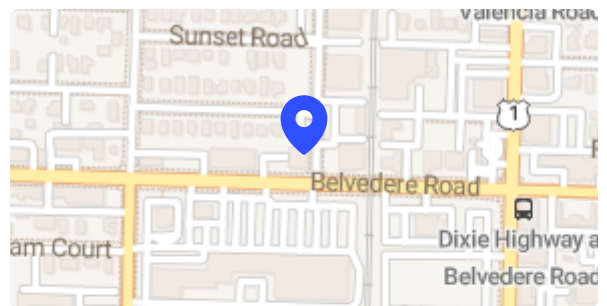

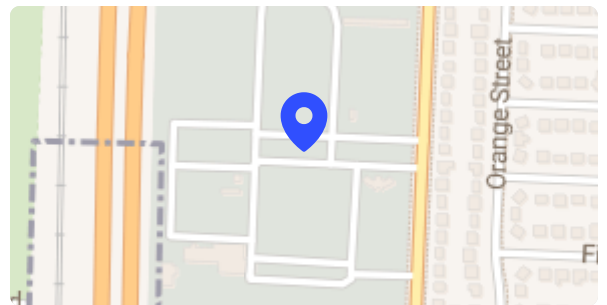
