Born on October 10, 1933, to Marjorie Emily (Wynaught) Harris and Elton Lowe Harris, Lois grew up with her brother, Richard E. Harris, who preceded her passing in early 2022. She graduated from East Providence High School. She successfully completed her post-high school graduate studies at Katherine Gibbs Secretarial School in Providence, Rhode Island. Lois and her beloved husband, Stuart Coman, Jr., (who preceded her in passing on July 17, 2022), were engaged to be married in 1954, while Stuart was serving in the United States Navy. Her legacy of love will always live on in the hearts of her family



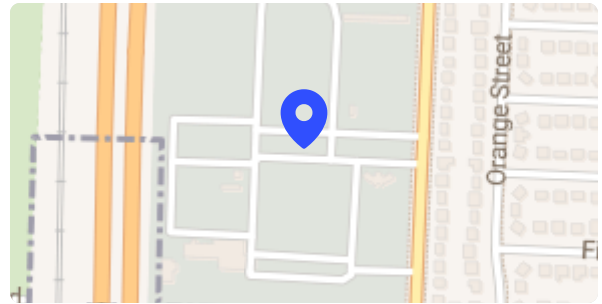

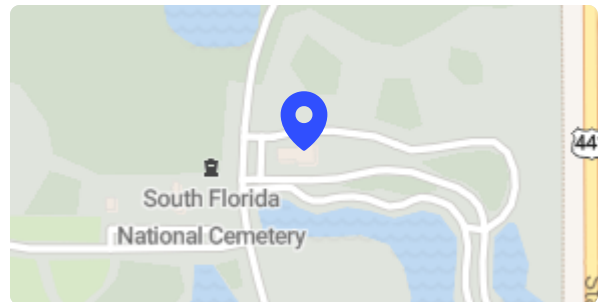

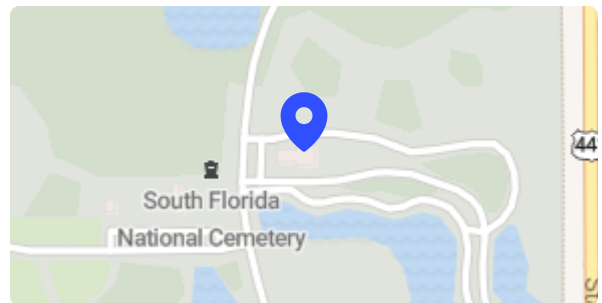
