Peter J. Michalczyn, 79, of Palm Beach Gardens, FL, passed away on March 29, 2026, at the VA Medical Center in West Palm Beach, Florida.

Born and raised in Hamilton, NJ, Pete proudly served his country as a Combat Medic in Vietnam after graduating from Rider College in Lawrenceville, NJ. He later carried on his family's legacy as the owner of Capitol City Aluminum Products in Trenton, NJ. Pete was predeceased by his parents, Peter P. and Catherine (Kostue) Michalczyn, and his sister, Maryann Michalczyn East.
